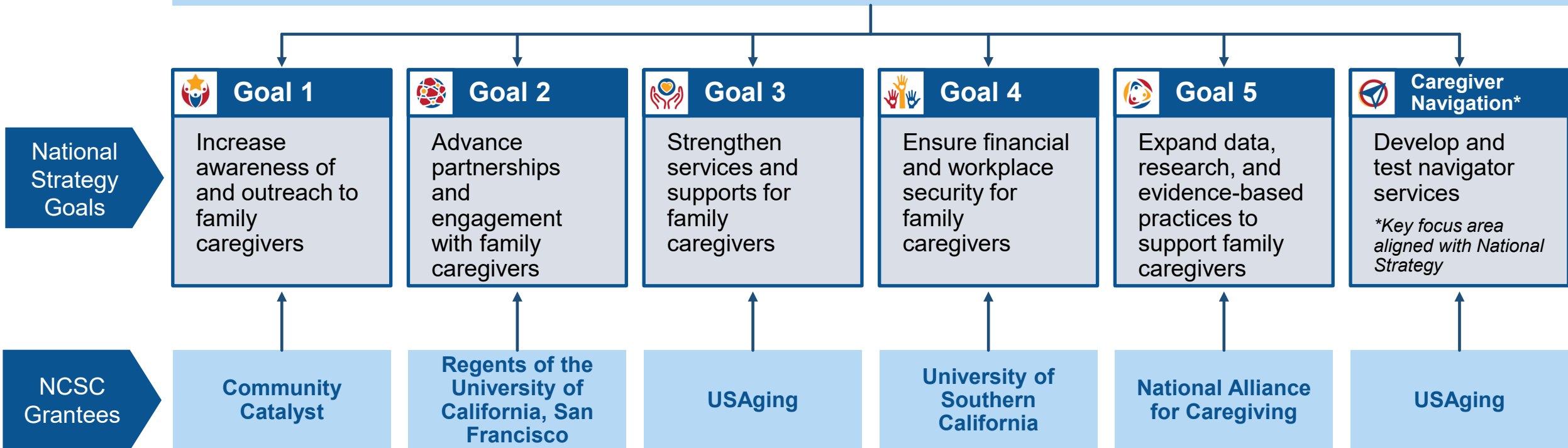

NCSC Alignment with National Strategy Goals

National Caregiver Support Collaborative (NCSC):

Identifies and disseminates caregiver support best practices related to each goal of the National Strategy through technical assistance (TA) to the aging network and the six NCSC grantees.



NCSC Outcomes: Key Highlights

Examples of the NCSC's measurable progress advancing the goals of the National Strategy to Support Family Caregivers include:

GOAL 1 Awareness & Outreach

The NCSC builds the capacity of the aging network to reach more caregivers and increase awareness of services and supports.

- The NCSC listserv grew **71%** in the past year to **2,466** subscribers, expanding the reach of caregiver support resources and strengthening organizations' ability to connect with caregivers.
- Learning collaborative participants from **11** states used the actionable Caregiver Assessment Checklist to strengthen their assessment practices, enhancing their ability to identify, reach, and engage caregivers.

GOAL 2 Partnership & Engagement

Organizations are committing to concrete actions that strengthen caregiver support.

- **74** organizations are participating across the four peer learning cohorts, illustrating broad, sustained engagement from across the aging network.
- Each peer learning participant commits to act on a caregiver support priority; the NCSC Technical Assistance is collecting pre- and post-series data to measure outcomes of participation and track their next steps.

GOALS 3–5 Services, Security & Evidence

The aging network is equipped with evidence-based and evidence-informed practices to assess needs and connect caregivers to services.

- Customizable Caregiver Assessment includes **107** expert-vetted questions informed by a **50-state** scan, which will help organizations understand caregiver needs and guide effective service planning.
- NCSC Financial & Workplace Security webinar reached **348** attendees and addressed live questions to support best practice implementation; **98%** of survey respondents indicated they learned something they can apply to their work.

CAREGIVER NAVIGATION Connecting across all goals

Caregiver navigation is strengthening coordinated support for caregivers across all National Strategy goals.

- NCSC Caregiver Navigation webinar drew **500+** attendees with **97%** of survey respondents indicating they learned something they can apply to their work.
- Targeted follow-up translated that engagement into new 1:1 technical assistance engagements.
