

- Four calls to 911 over 2 months as, "a sick person, a traumatic injury, or a breathing problem"
- 80-year-old female, multiple chronic conditions, living alone with limited support from family
- Covered by Medicare, Kaiser and Medi-Cal with \$2,380 share of cost
- 911 complaints: anxiety, knee pain, or abdominal pain
- 2 paramedic transports at different Kaiser hospitals
