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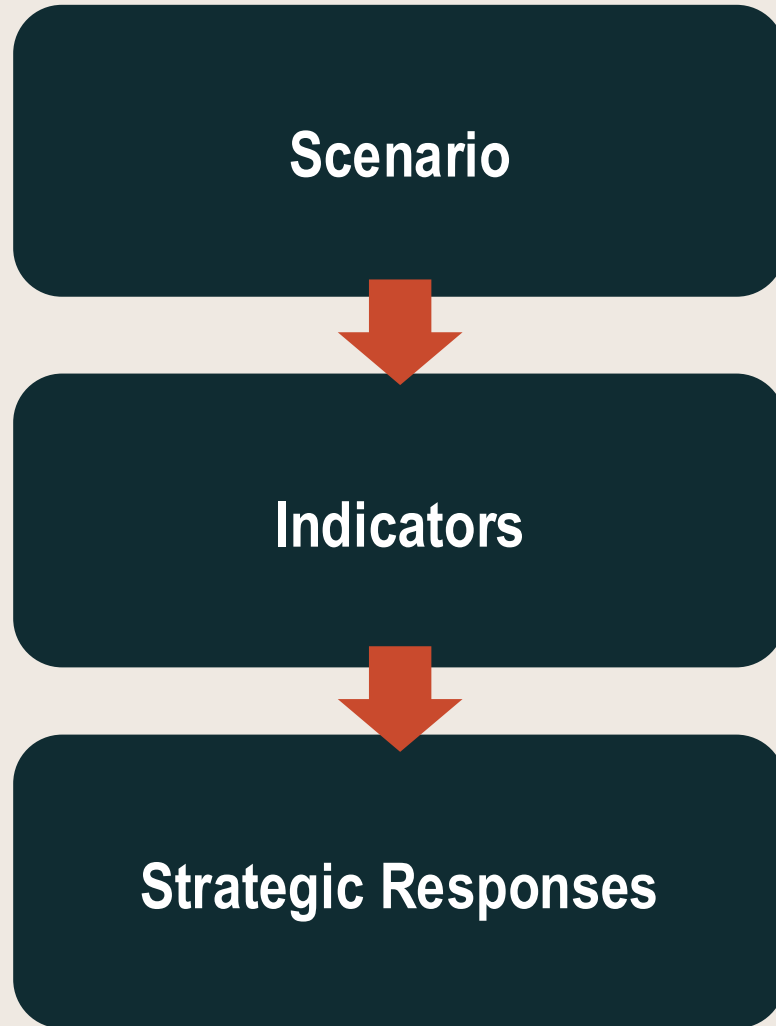

The Scenario Planning Framework



Plausible future environments or conditions that may impact your organization, community, funding, workforce, partnerships, or service delivery.

Preserve & Stabilize

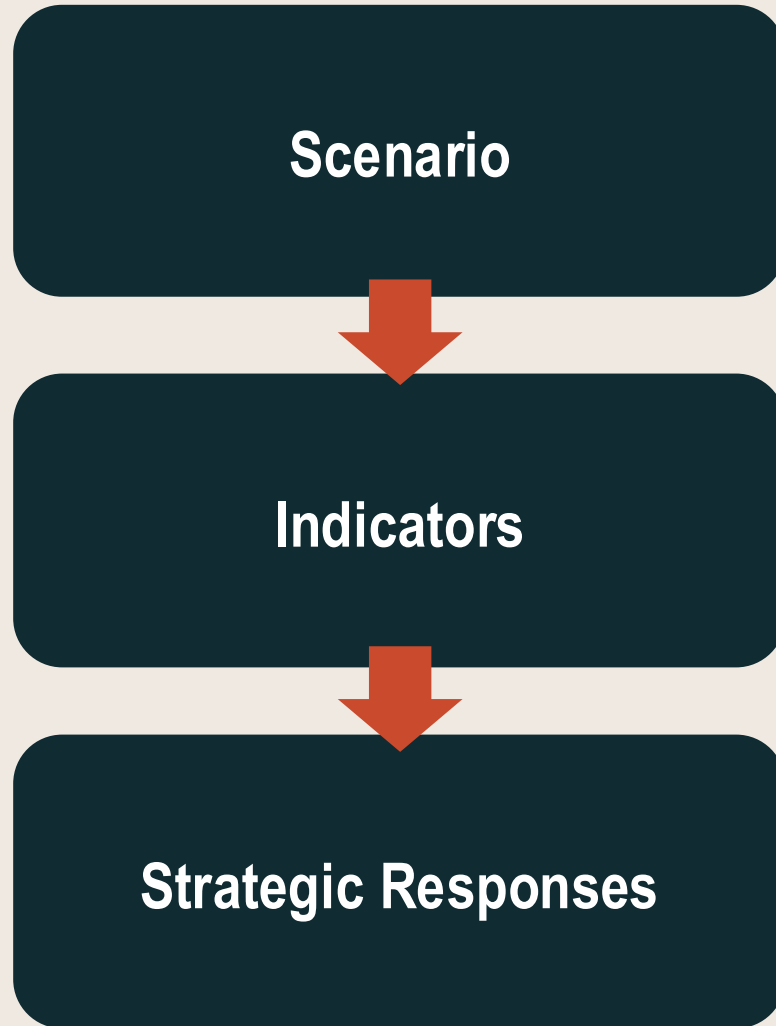


Transformation

Reinvent & Adapt



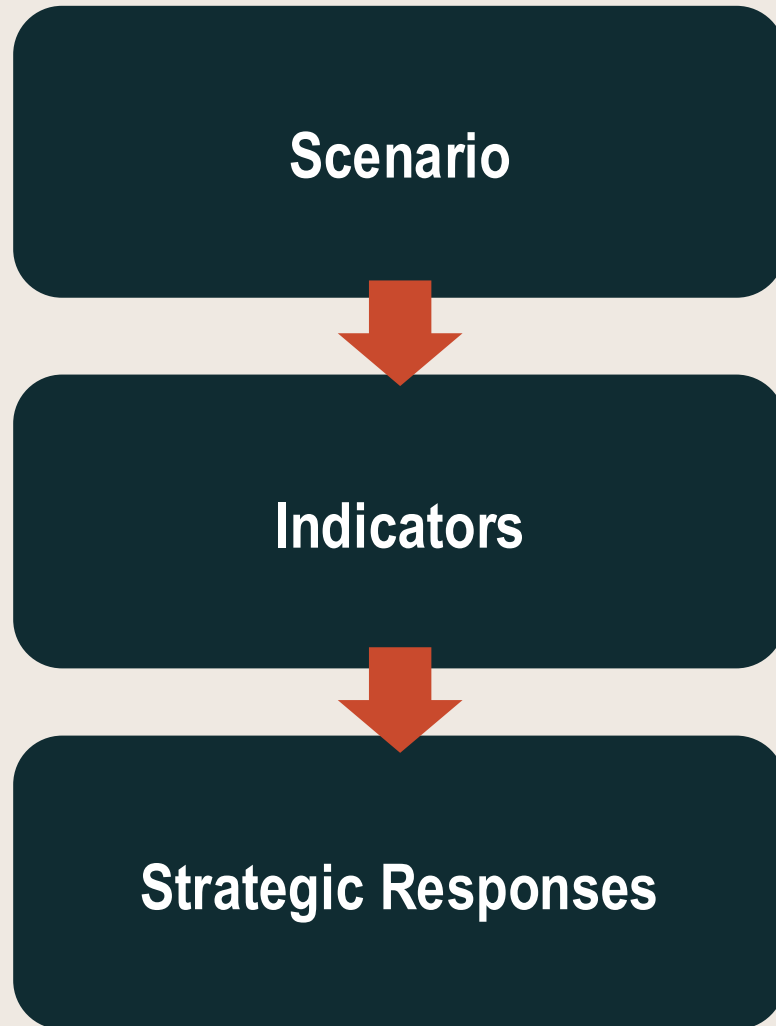
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Early signs that suggest which future scenario may be unfolding. Indicators are observable, distinctive, timely, and reliable.

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The actions an organization will take if a particular scenario begins to emerge. Strategic responses are actionable, feasible, and time-bound.
